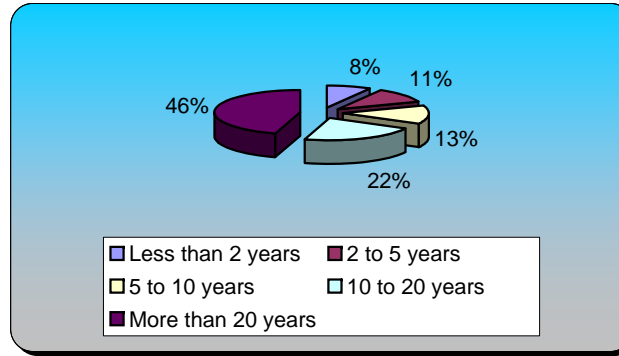

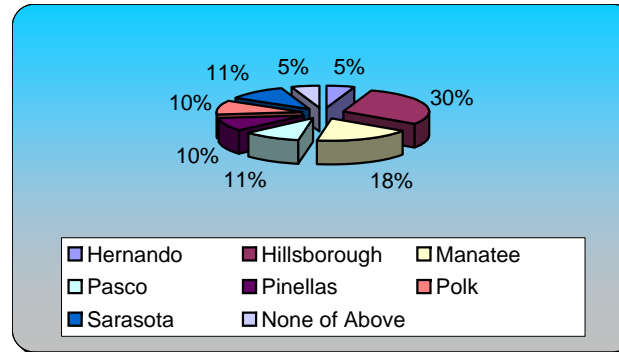

4.) In Which County Do You Work?

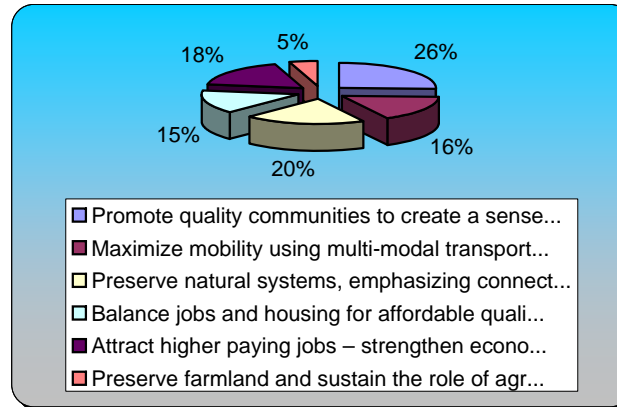

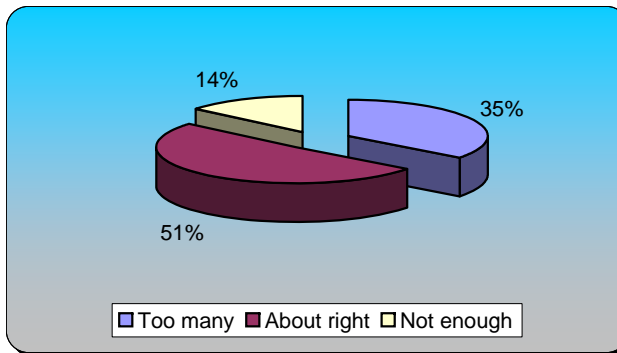

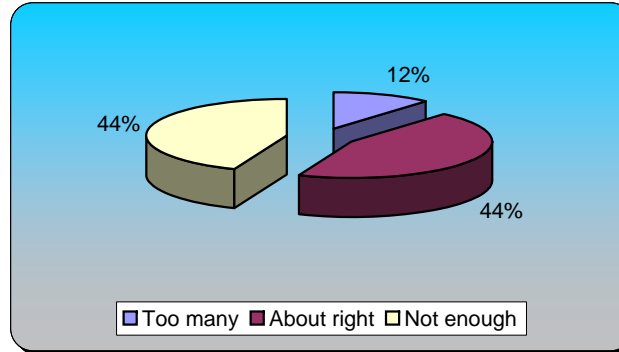
6.) How do you feel about the number of yellow Legos provided in the exercise as a representation of future population?

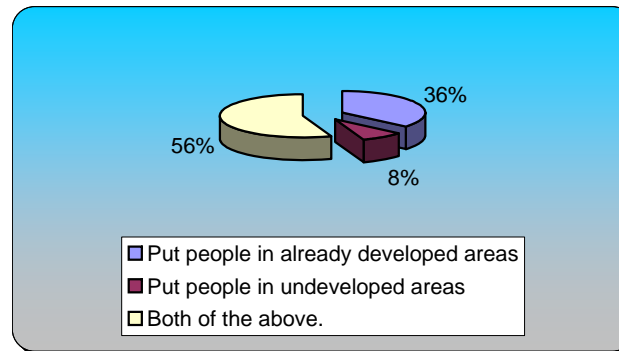
7.) How do you feel about the number of red Legos provided in the exercise as a representation of future employment (jobs)?

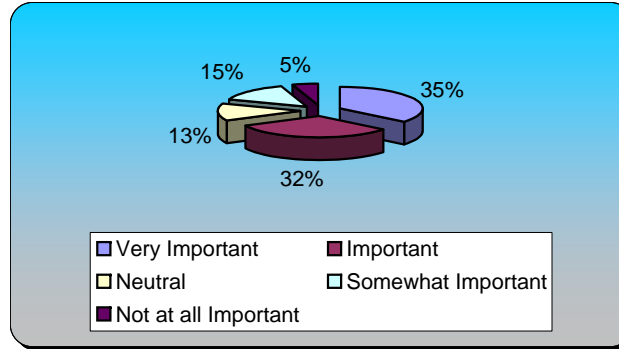

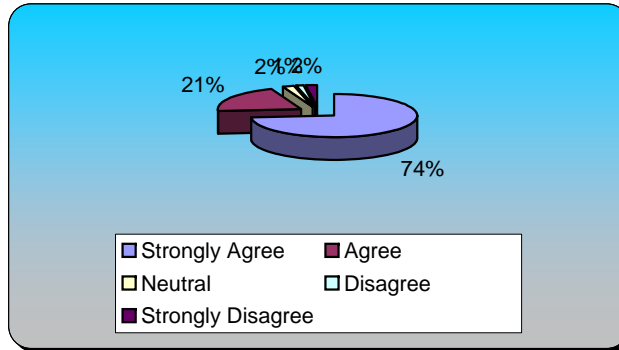
9.) How important is retaining the character of rural communities in the Tampa Bay region?

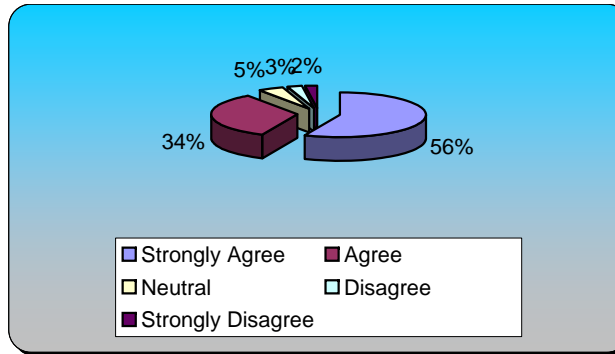

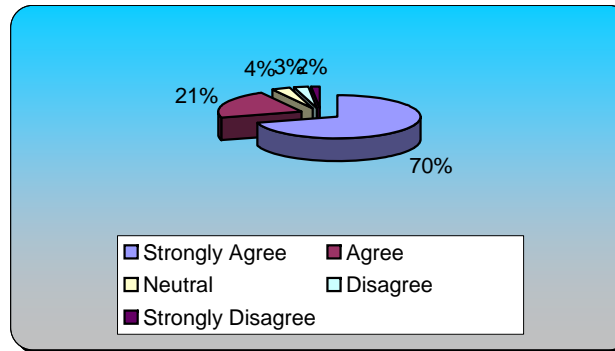

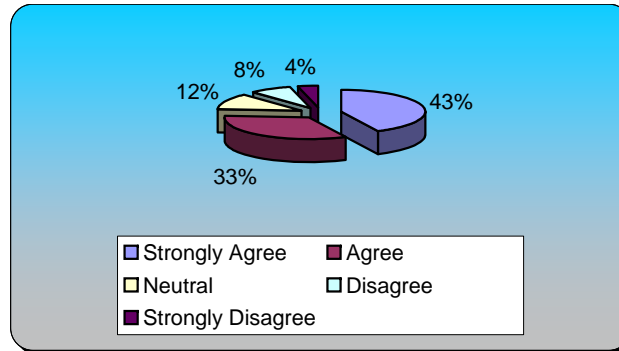

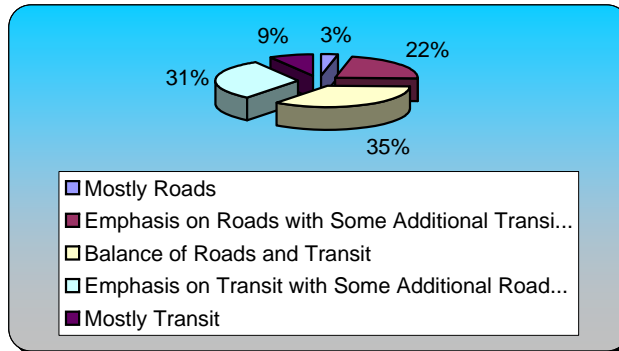

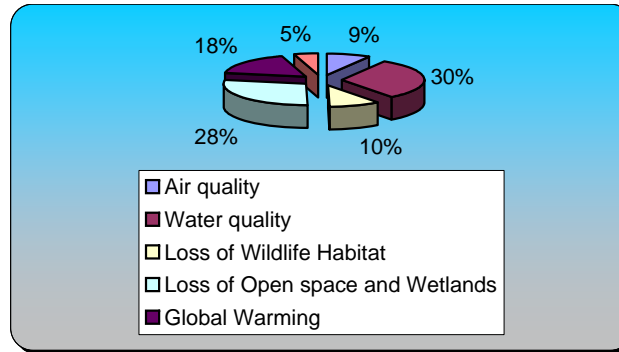

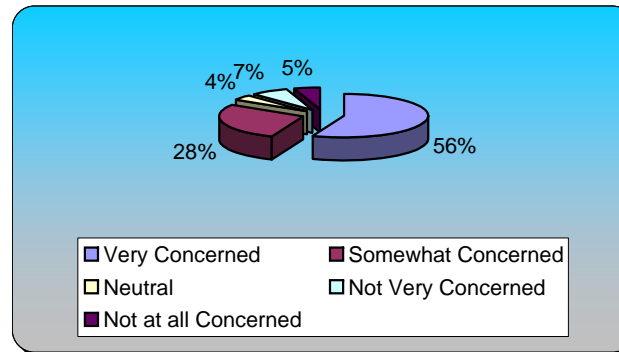

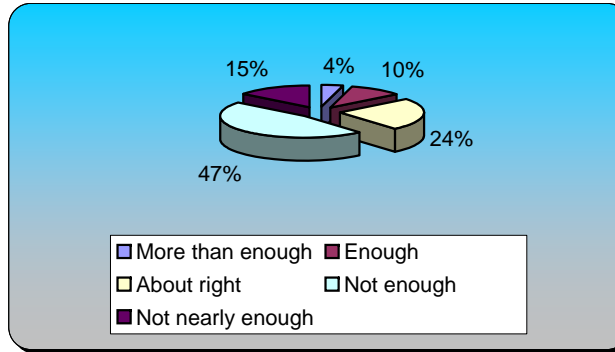

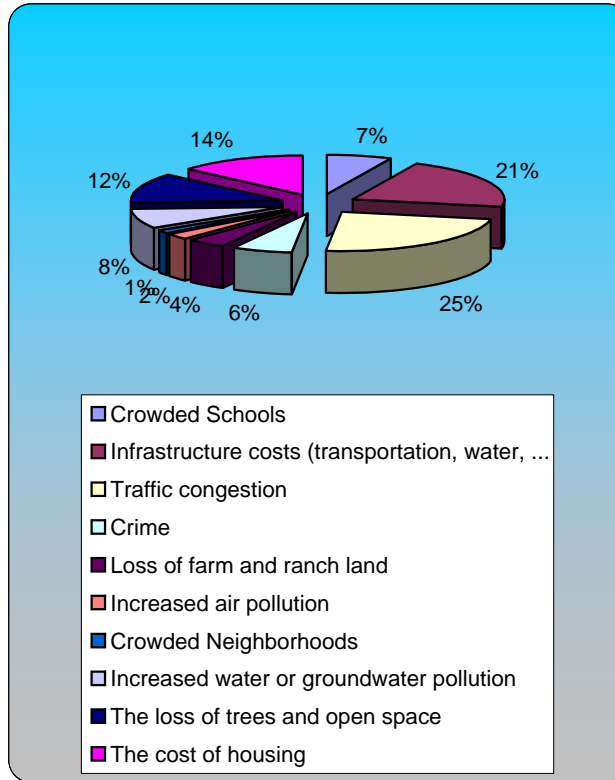

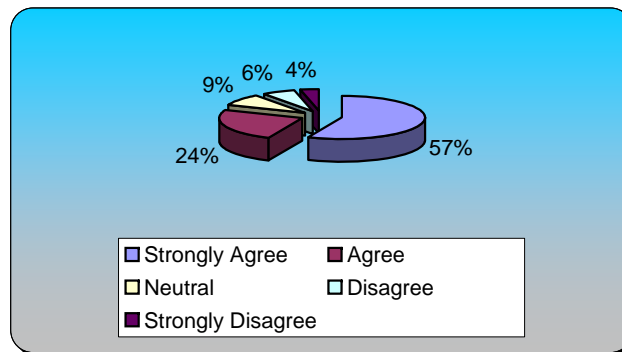
